Assemble at **Harbourfront Centre, Counter #02-22, Penguin Ferries Service** to collect your boarding pass, stickers and ferry tickets. Depart by high speed ferry to Batam.

Upon arrival at **Batam Centre International Ferry Terminal**, proceed for immigration & customs clearance. At the arrival exit, you will be greeted by our friendly tour guide, wearing green shirt with the welcome sign: "**DESINDO TOURS**" and escorted to a waiting air-conditioned coach.



Proceed for 1-Day Batam-Bareleng Historical Tour. En route, visit the **BARELANG FISABILILAH BRIDGE**, which is the biggest bridge linking the tiny islands of Tonton and Nipah to the larger Setoko, Rempang, Galang and Galang Baru Islands. The 1st bridge connecting Batam to Tonton Island is impressive with its 38 metres-high spans and is 642 metres in length. Next, proceed to visit the plantation of the bizarre-looking **Dragon Fruit** (pitaya), located in 16 hectares of orchard fruits with more than 80,000 trees. Thereafter, continue the tour to visit **CAMP VIETNAM (NGHA TRANG MEMORIAL WALL, THE MONUMENT OF BOAT PEOPLE, GALANG MUSEUM, VIETNAMESE VILLAGE and QUAN AN DU MONASTERY)**. This is the site of 80 acres of land located on Galang Island, Batam in Riau Province, where 250,000 Vietnamese

refugees were housed from 1979 to 1996. Thereafter, proceed for seafood lunch at **GOLDEN PRAWN 555 SEAFOOD RESTAURANT**. Built with wood and bamboo over the sea, you will be served with a variety of Indonesian traditional seafood dishes, enjoying the nice view of north-eastern coast of Batam. En route, you will stop-by at **GTS LOCAL SHOP**, where you may wish to purchase local product such as Coffee, Batiks, Handicrafts and more.

After lunch, your next program will be the **KUDA LUMPING CULTURAL DANCE**, where you will be entertained by local villagers with their traditional trance dance. Thereafter, stop-by at **BENGGONG DRY MARKET**, where you may wish to purchase local fresh dry food stuff such as ikan bilis, udang kering and many more. Thereafter, visit the **THOA PEK KONG CHINESE TEMPLE**, where the famous and oldest Chinese temple in Batam Island is. It was moved from Singapore's Kusu Island during 1980's. En route, visit the **POLO OUTLETS**, where you can purchase clothes by American brand Polo Ralph Lauren, which were made in Jakarta and are cheaper than in Singapore. Lastly, drop-off at **NAGOYA HILL SHOPPING MALL** (Batam Vivo City), which is the biggest shopping mall in Batam with Matahari Departmental Store (famous department stall chain in Indonesia) as well as Hypermart supermarket located here; the Food Street in Nagoya Hill Shopping Mall offering you with many choice of food outlets like A&W, KFC and many local food retail outlets.

In the evening, assemble and transfer to Batam Centre Terminal for your ferry back to Singapore, bringing home fond and sweet memories of Batam.
