Day 01 (SAT) : SINGAPORE (GA877 1610/1720hrs) – JOGJAKARTA (Yogyakarta) (Meal-On-Board/Dinner)

Upon arrival at Adisucipto Airport – Yogyakarta, meet-and-greet service by our tour guide and proceed to local restaurant for your dinner. Thereafter, check-in to hotel.

Day 02 (SUN) : JOGJAKARTA – Full-Day Tour (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast at hotel, you will visit the **Sultan Palace** or **Kraton**, to see traditional Javanese crafts and renowned **Taman Sari Water Castle**. Next, visit the **Yogya Return Monument** – the history of Indonesia's struggle against the colonial power from 1945 – 1950. Then, proceed to the world's famous **Borobudur Temple** – built in the 9th century by Cailendra King, it was once of the greatest Buddhist monument in the world. Also known as one of the ancient wonders of the world! A popular religious and historical site visited by numerous Buddhists throughout the world, it rises on a hill overlooking lush green fields and distance hills. This magnificent ancient wonder is like the pyramid of the Buddhist world. A climb to the top of the temple will give one a sense of achievement and be rewarded with a panoramic and scenic view of the surrounding area. You will also drive pass some important temples such as **Mendut Temple** and **Pawon Temple**.

Afterwards, continue your journey to **Ketep Pass** to have a bird's eye view of **Merapi Volcano** (Mount Merapi) and visit the **Museum Merapi** where you can enjoy the video presentation of Mount Merapi. This is the most active live volcano of Indonesia, which had erupted as recent as April 2006. From Ketep Pass and with clear skies, you will have a good view of Mount Merapi here, which is a good and safe distance in case of any eruption. On your way back to Yogyakarta, you will visit a silverware centre to understand and have a close-up experience on the process of how silverwares are made. Same experience will follow too at the Batik factory. Then, have a short stop at **Sleman Village** where you can buy local famous fruit – **Salak Pondoh** (snake skin fruit). Next, proceed to Yogya's famous shopping street – **Malioboro Street** and **Pasar Bringharjo** (traditional market). At these two places, you can find wide array of handicrafts like Batik, wooden sculpture, souvenirs and local delicacies (Bakpia), then dinner at local restaurant.



Day 03 (MON) : JOGJAKARTA – SOLO – PARANGTRITIS (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast at hotel, proceed to Solo and embark on Solo's sightseeing tour, making your first stop at **Mangkunegara Palace (Keraton Solo)**. Then, proceed to **Klewer Market** that sells traditional Solo Batik as well as **Triwindhu Market** where you can find antiques. Next, pass through the longest river in Java Island, **Solo River**. This is the river that a popular Malay folk song **Bengawan Solo** was written on, which many Singaporeans are very familiar with. Thereafter, proceed back to Yogyakarta for you lunch. Then, proceed to **Kasongan Village** to have a close-up look at how the locals produce various handicrafts such as earthenware and ceramics for decorative and practical usages (kitchen utensils).

Next, drive to **Parangtritis Beach** – the tour begins with a drive through the lovely countryside of **Seribu (Thousand) Hill** where you can enjoy browsing and if you are daring enough, take a horse ride. For the less adventurous ones, you can have an option to ride on a "Bendi" – a two-wheel-horse-drawn buggy). These are options at your own expenses. The trip will end at the nearby hilltop of **Gupit** where you can enjoy the breathtaking view of sunset from atop. Then, return to Yogya for your dinner and free at leisure before you retire for the day.



Day 04 (TUE) : JOGJAKARTA (GA876 1800/2110hrs) – SINGAPORE (Breakfast/Meal-On-Board)

After breakfast at hotel, free at leisure for your last-minute shopping until time for hotel check-out and departure transfer to airport for your flight back to Singapore, bringing home fond memories of Jogjakarta!

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
